*****IMPORTANT*****

- 1. If you purchase Type A Feed Medications from New Vision Coop and you are the end user of the Medication(s) you will be required to sign a Veterinary Feed Directive (VFD) Letter of Understanding. New Vision Coop will keep this form on file for a minimum of two years and a new form must be signed every two years.**
- 2. If you purchase any Veterinary Feed Directive (VFD) medication(s) or feed(s) that you intend to further distribute you will be required to sign an Acknowledgement to Distribute form. New Vision Coop will keep this form on file for a minimum of two years and a new form must be signed every two years.**
- 3. If you purchase Type B or C Medicated feeds from New Vision Coop and you are the end user of the Type B or C Medicated feed, New Vision Coop must have a valid Veterinary Feed Directive (VFD) on file for the Type B or C Medicated feed purchased.**
